### Evaluation Methods Used:

The site was tested using the latest versions of Chrome, Firefox and Safari. Assistive technology used was NVDA, JAWS, VoiceOver and ZoomText. Manual assessments were done by examining how screen readers interpreted content, keyboard navigation functionality, and color contrast. Additionally, Automated tools were used to scan and identify accessibility issues across the website. The tools included, but are not limited to, AXE (Firefox and Chrome plug-in) and Web Accessibility Toolbar (WAT).
